The Museum looks after a timeless collection of clocks, watches, other timepieces, tools, instruments, books and valuable archival documents brought together since 1858. The Museum Trust makes these resources available to academics, researchers, students and members of the general public. In 2018 we saw significant change at the Museum Trust with the appointment of a Museum Manager, Collections Officer and, in 2021, a Librarian. As a result, we are now pleased to open the Museum doors more regularly and undertake a number of new projects. The scheme has now welcomed over 50 members.
